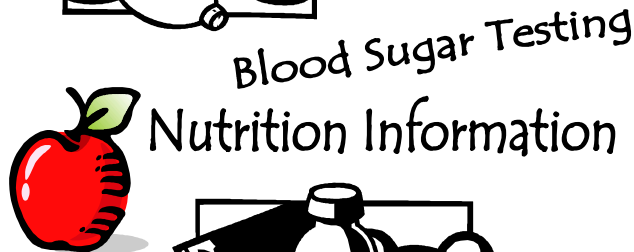
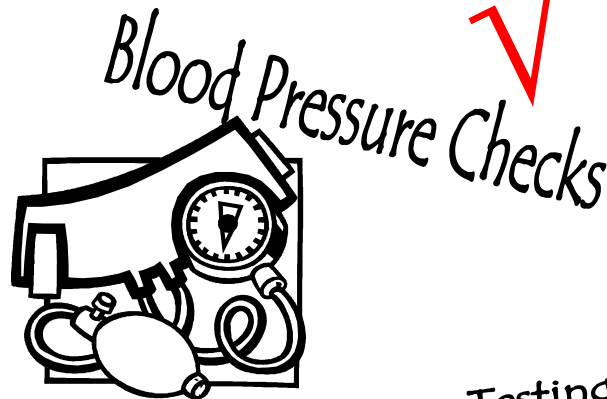

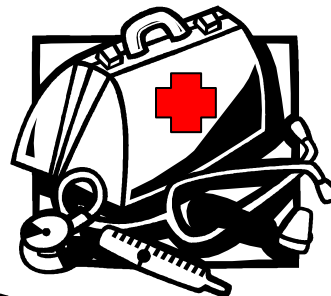

Serving the Community

The School & Family Health Centers are open to all members of the community.

The Centers work closely with the schools to offer information, services, and programs best suited to the needs of the students. Classroom programs follow the NC Standard Course of Study guidelines. The centers also work with community members, local health agencies—including communication with family physician, and the Mitchell Community Health Partnership, to serve the needs of the community.

Method of Payment

The Centers receive revenue from fee-for-service billing. Payments are accepted from insurance companies and individuals.

For enrolled students, insurance payments are accepted as full payment for services. Community members are responsible for the balance of their bill. Sliding scale fees can be arranged for individuals who may need extra assistance with their bill.
